Dwight is a combat veteran with multiple deployments in support of operations in Bosnia, South Korea, Afghanistan, and Iraq.

Dwight received his Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration Operations Management from Auburn University and a Master of Aviation Science with Distinction from Embry Riddle. He was a Distinguished Graduate of the U.S. Air Force Air Command and Staff College and was awarded a Master of Military Operational Arts and Science.
